







Doctoral Dissertation Proposal Fellowship (up to 8 awards per year)

The \$3000 award is for doctoral students developing their dissertation proposal and it supports costs related to prefieldwork surveys, literature review and dissertation proposal writing over 3 months. Fellows attend 2 workshops designed by the program to help them develop and strengthen their research and network with peers and experts.

> Doctoral Dissertation Research Fellowship (up to 14 awards per year)

The award supports **doctoral students** with **\$15,000** over 6-12 months to enable them to carry out fieldwork, collect and analyze data and work on their literature review and dissertation writing. Fellows attend 2 workshops designed by the program to provide guidance on research methods, writing and publishing. Doctoral Dissertation Completion Fellowship (up to 16 awards per year)

The award supports **doctoral students** with **\$10,000** to allow them to take a one-year leave from teaching and other responsibilities to focus on data analysis and scholarly writing to complete their doctoral dissertations and meet their degree requirements. Fellows attend one workshop where they receive mentoring on their research methods and dissertation writing and network with peers and experts.

Post-Doctoral Writing Fellowship (up to 6 awards per year)

The award, exclusive to former Next Gen fellows, provides post-doctoral students with \$3000 over 6 months to complete an article or book manuscript. It will allow fellows to focus on finalizing an article for a peer-reviewed journal or completing a book manuscript based on their Next Gen-supported doctoral dissertation. Fellows attend one writing and dissemination workshop designed by the program.
